Licencing

All versions of this software are licenced for free use by the PAGB, its member Federations, and their member Clubs. Modification is permitted under the 'open source' rules ie, all modifications must be made freely available under the same conditions as the original licence.

Version Prefix

'A' means Access 2000. Later versions of Access may also be suitable but have not been tested.

'E' means Excel 2000. Later versions of Excel are suitable and Excel 2010 has been tested. All use of Excel requires enabling of macros (Security setting).

Previous Versions

Versions before A207 and E207 used a different character set for the scores.

Versions A2xx, E2xx, A301 and E301 to E307 are now replaced.

Current Version (E308 – August 2020)

- Handset testing.
- Multi-judge mode with 2-8 judges
 - Scores 1-5 or 2-5 per judge
 - Visibility adjustment of the individual judge scores
 - Total score calculation from individual judge's scores
 - Ability to define one or more judges as inactive, with their scores not counting to the total.
 - Optional logging of the individual judges' scores.
 - Optional integration with an Entries list for announcing titles and recording the judges' total scores.
- Single-judge mode, where an Entries list is used for announcing.
 - Scores are entered manually by the operator and recorded on the Entries list, with half marks and held back allowed.
 - Held Back form to simplify scoring residual images.
- When an Entries list is used, additional functions are:
 - Creation of manual score sheet.
 - Quick recording of Awards on the Entries list and available for reports.
 - Creation of histogram, summary and detail results reports after scoring.

Follow-on Version (E401)

Version E401 is based on E306 with addition of barcode reading as a means of selecting the next image to score. This is relevant only when:

- Scoring prints which have been previously labelled with a barcode.
- Using an integrated list on the Entries sheet in the scoring system.
- Digital images of the prints are not being projected in synchronisation. There is no link to a database of image files.

Version E401 remains a development.
